New York, Jan. 29.—Cotton—Today's short session was quiet and course of prices was steadily downward under moderate pressure and lack of support. The South was a seller here, supposedly on the new crop prospects and there are further evidences of a wider tendency to withdrawal of commitments on the present crop on the idea that the market for this season's yield has virtually settled down to a question of barter cotton and the spinners. Speculative interest is likely to remain quiet until new crop news becomes more plentiful.
