SHORT WEIGHT IN COAL FOR GOV'T VESSELS

Western Fuel Company Was Below Standard Measure in Supplying Transports, - Counsel Says.

San Francisco, Dec. 15.—Taking of evidence in the trial of eight indicted officials and employees of the Western Fuel Company, alleged to have defrauded against the United States government began today.

Matt I. Sullivan, special counsel for the government, told the jury he was prepared to prove each defendant was cognizant of the alleged fraud and had profited by it.

Sullivan separated the alleged frauds into five divisions—short weighing of coal imported from the company's mines in British Columbia, short weighing of coal sold to American ships, short weighing of coal sold to government transports and other government-owned vessels.

Villa Grows Anxious. Villa, Dec. 15.—While rebel headquarters in Juarez today were sending urgent messages to General Villa, the rebel commander at Chihuahua, telling him he was incurring the displeasure of foreign countries in his action toward Spaniards and other foreigners, and asking him to modify his attitude.

Reports were that federals were advancing toward Chihuahua from Torreon, about 200 miles south. Villa had to scatter his forces by sending troops to surround the federals at Ojinaga, on the border, while garrisoning Juarez and Chihuahua.

An attack on Chihuahua, which is not regarded as imminent, would cut Villa off from any base on the border. It was conceded by rebels that the first act of the federals, should they arrive in the vicinity of Chihuahua, would be to stop all telegraph and railroad communication.

The plan which the rebel forces think best to carry out is to try to work out, is to draw as many as possible toward Ojinaga, while federals from the south reach Chihuahua. The rebels believe this federal activity southward may be merely a preparation to check Villa's projected march on Torreon.

STRENGTHENED BY TREATY TERMS

Treaty Provides for Investigation of Misunderstandings - Naval and Military Status Quo May be Maintained.

Washington, Dec. 15.—Secretary Bryan and Chevalier Van Rappard, the Netherlands minister, today agreed upon the terms of a peace treaty embodying the principles of the arbitration plan announced early in the present administration.

The negotiation of the peace treaty constitutes the most important work to be undertaken by the Netherlands minister, who assumed the Netherlands mission here only last month.

The principal feature of the peace plan as announced by Secretary Bryan is a provision for an investigation throughout a period of at least one year of any misunderstanding between the signatory nations, by a commission of five members, one to be chosen from each of the contracting countries.

From the outset Mr. Bryan has maintained that the principle of investigation being accepted the other details are matters for conference and compromise.

PAID DEBT OF CONSCIENCE

Montreal Men Failed Ten Years Ago Yesterday Paid All Creditors in Full to Square Conscience.

Montreal, Dec. 15.—Ten years ago George and Samuel Rabinovitch, retail dry goods merchants at St. Guillaume De Upton, failed and the creditors whose accounts amounted to over \$150,000 received nine and half cents on the dollar when the estate was wound up.

Today thirty-five of the remaining creditors whose accounts varied from \$9.88 to \$688.74 and totalling \$9,814.96, were surprised to receive cheques reversing the amount of their claims.

British Columbia Judge Rebukes Minister. Clergyman in Sermon Accused Authorities of Negligence in Dealing with the Nanaimo Riots.

Vancouver, B. C., Dec. 15.—Justice Morrison this morning administered a rebuke to Rev. Dr. V. H. Fraser, because the latter had commented in a sermon last evening on the Nanaimo riot cases now before the special assize.

Dr. Fraser had accused Sir Richard McBride and the provincial and dominion governments of negligence in not averting the labor trouble and of not effecting a settlement subsequently, and expressed the opinion that the mine owners deliberately introduced strike breakers into the struggle between the men and the operators with a view to working up a climax so that the militia would be called to the district.

The preacher said he thought that the mine owners should be in jail for their activities, as in his belief, they were really responsible for the riots.

85 CARGO FOR SEVEN FREIGHT RECEIVED

Two Section Special Left Montreal - Royal George Will Take Over 800,000 Letters This Trip.

Montreal, Dec. 15.—It took a special train, run in two sections of four cars each tonight, to convey Jack Canuck's Christmas mail to John Bull. There will be other big shipments of mail greetings and more tangible matter to the Old Country, but the loads sent away this evening contain the letters and packages that will get to the old folks, wives, and sweethearts in time for Christmas Eve, which is even more of a festival over there than Christmas day is here.

The mountains of mail that are timed by travel by the Royal George, from St. John today include over eight hundred thousand ordinary letters, 7,230 parcels, 17,107 registered letters and packages, besides four hundred sacks of newspapers.
