Thus you have before you nothing, which you are going to get a patent for, and no attorney's fee is charged unless you get a Patent. A lawyer whose fee depends on his success in obtaining a Patent will not advise that your invention is patentable. It is usually is patentable, as far as the Government can tell in determining the question: here you can rely on the advice given after a preliminary examination made by **Design Patents and Registration of Labels, Trade Marks and Inventions secured.** Caveats prepared and filed, applications in revivor of Rejected, Abandoned, or Forfeited Cases made. Very often valuable inventions are saved in these classes of cases. If you have undertaken to secure your own patent and failed, a skilful handling of the case may still succeed.
