It is His Excellency's further pleasure, that all officers appointed to review the Battalions of Militia shall pay particular attention to the performance of every part of these regulations, and to report their observations thereupon, for his information; so that the exact uniformity required in all movements may be attained and preserved, and his Excellency's intention thereby carried into full effect.
