Has taken an active part in military matters, having had command of No. 3 Co. 39th Batt. of the Rifles for a period of 15 years. First returned to Leg. Assem. at g. e. 1879, and re-elected at last g.e. A Liberal Conservative.—Walsingham Centre, Ont.
