X Nothing in this Act contained shall be taken to repeal or in any manner to affect or interfere with a certain Act of the Legislature of Upper Canada, passed in the fifty-fourth year of the reign of His late Majesty King George the Third, intituled, An Act to declare certain persons therein described, Aliens, and to vest their estates in His Majesty, or any proceedings had under the said Act.

False swearing to be perjury—and to forfeit the benefits of this Act.

XI. Any person who shall wilfully swear falsely, or make any false affirmation under the authority of this Act, before any Justice of the 10 Peace, or before any person having ex officio the power and authority of Justice of the Peace as aforesaid, shall be deemed guilty of wilful and corrupt perjury, and every such person shall, on conviction thereof, in addition to any other punishment authorized by law, forfeit all the privileges and advantages which he or she would otherwise, by making such 15 oath or affirmation, have been entitled to under this Act; but the rights of others in respect to estates derived from or held under him or her, shall not thereby be prejudiced, excepting always such others as shall have been cognizant of the perjury at the time the title by which they claim to hold under him or her was created.
