
NORTH WEST TERRITORIES :

1. Bill to make further provision for the Government thereof; From the Senate, 172. Read, 173. Read second and third times; Passed, 216. R. A., 265. (36 Vic., c. 5.)

2. Bill respecting the administration of Justice, and the establishment of a police force in the North West Territories; Presented, 268. Committed; Considered, 340. Resolutions providing for salaries &c., referred; Bill considered and amended; Reported; Passed, 409. By the Senate, 429. R. A., 436. (36 Vic., c. 35.)

3. House resolves to go into committee, to consider of providing for the expenses attending the same, 270. Considered; Report several Resolutions, 407. Referred to committee on the Bill, 409. See *supra*, 2.

4. Bill further to amend the Act to make further provision for the Government of the North West Territories; From the Senate; Read, 330. Considered and amended in committee; Reported; Passed, as amended, 423. Amendments agreed to by Senate, 429. R. A., 435. (36 Vic., c. 34.)

Motion that a geographical and geological survey of the Territories should be at once undertaken, and that information thus obtained as to the climate and resources of the Fertile Belt should be circulated in Canada, Great Britain, Germany, and Northern Europe, with a view to promote emigration; Debate thereon adjourned, 196.

6. Petition of Sheriff Treadwell, praying that the Indians in the Territories may be engaged in the construction of the Pacific Railway, and that the Buffalo and other game may be protected, 242.
