

BILL.

An Act to confirm the survey verifying the division line between the Townships of Grantham and Upton.

WHEREAS for many years doubts have existed as to the true position of the South-west line of the Township of Grantham, in the District of Three Rivers, between the said Township and the Township of Upton, in the District of St. Hyacinthe, and have given rise to several law suits, questions of conflicting jurisdiction, and other difficulties; And whereas, under instructions from the Commissioner of Crown Lands, bearing date at Toronto, the fourteenth day of May, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven, W. W. O'Dwyer, Provincial Land Surveyor, surveyed and bounded the said line in the field, as appears by his Report (*procès verbal*) of the survey and bounding (*bornage*) of the said line, bearing date the twentieth day of October, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-seven, and filed and deposited in the office of the said Commissioner of Crown Lands: And whereas the proprietors of land in that part of the said Township of Upton which lies adjacent to the said line, have petitioned to have the said survey confirmed by authority of the Legislature, and it is just and expedient to comply with their request; Therefore Her Majesty, &c., by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

Preamble.

I. The line surveyed and bounded by the said W. W. O'Dwyer, as appears by the said Report (*procès verbal*) and by the plan accompanying the same, shall be and is hereby declared to be the south-west outline of the said Township of Grantham, and the true and unalterable division line between the said Township of Grantham and the said Township of Upton.

O'Dwyer's line declared the true S. W. boundary of Grantham.

II. The stones, posts, and other boundary monuments planted by the said W. W. O'Dwyer, or verified by him, to mark the said division line, shall be and are hereby declared to be the true and unalterable boundary marks of the said division line between the said Townships.

Stones, etc., planted by him to be boundary marks:

III. One copy of the said Report (*procès verbal*) and of the plan accompanying the same, shall be deposited in the office of the Registrar for the County of Bagot, and another copy in the office of the Registrar for the County of Drummond.

Copies of his report and plan to be registered.

IV. This Act shall be deemed a Public Act.
