# GEORGI II. REGIS.

C A P. XX.

An Act to continue until the Twenty-fifth Day of *March* One thousand eight hundred and ten, several Laws relating to the Encouragement of the *Greenland* Whale Fisheries; to the Admission to Entry in *Great Britain* of Oil and Blubber of *Newfoundland* taken by His Majesty's Subjects carrying on the Fishery from and residing in the said Island; and to the allowing the Importation of Fish from *Newfoundland* and the Coast of *Labrador*.

[21st *March* 1808.]

**W**HEREAS the Laws herein-after mentioned have by Experience been found useful and beneficial, and it is expedient that the same should be further continued; be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That an Act made in the Twenty-sixth Year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, *An Act for the further Support and Encouragement of the Fisheries carried on in the Greenland Seas and Davis's Streights*, which was to be in force for Five Years, from the Twenty-fifth Day of *December* One thousand
