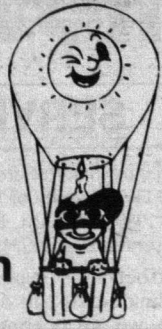

- Full Term: May 6 - June 14
- 1st Term: May 6 - May 24 with classes held on Saturday, May 11 in lieu of the Victoria Day Holiday (Monday, May 20)
- 2nd Term: May 27 - June 14

Students who have never attended the University of Alberta must submit an Application for Admission form along with complete and official transcripts of academic records by **March 1, 1985**. The Registration form must be returned to the students' Faculty Office before the deadline date of **March 29, 1985**. As registration in some courses is limited, students are urged to submit all appropriate forms as early as possible.

SUMMER SESSION 1985 is scheduled as follows:

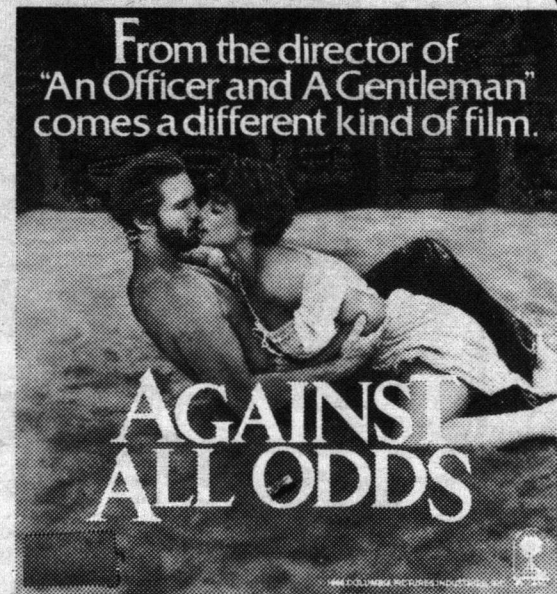
- Full Term: July 2 - August 9
- 1st Term: July 2 - July 19 with classes held on Saturday, July 6 in lieu of the July 1 holiday.
- 2nd Term: July 22 - August 9 with classes held on Saturday, July 27 in lieu of the Civic Holiday (Monday, August 5)
