

# Rockwood deferral approved

Peel Board of Education's request for the deferment of a \$6.4 million grant for the construction of Rockwood Secondary School has been granted by the Ministry of Education.

However, the deferment will have no effect on the ministry's decision to allocate building funds for Peel's top priority — Erin Mills Secondary School.

Funding for Erin Mills and Rockwood are not

related," said Ray MacPherson, chief architect for the ministry and chairman of the provincial priorities committee. "It's just not a case of one or the other."

Last year MacPherson

received requests for nearly \$250 million worth of grants but received an allotment of only \$71 million. The Peel board has requested \$8.45 million to build Erin Mills this year.

Bill Kent, chairman of the Peel board, told The Times the board thought it necessary to defer the building of Rockwood for one year after projected enrolments for the school failed to materialize.

### Leave request nixed

A Brampton high school teacher's request for leave of absence without pay was rejected by Peel Board of Education trustees last week.

Coleen Byrne, a J.A. Turner Secondary School instructor who wanted a leave of absence to travel and work in India and Nepal for a year, will not be allowed a leave because she has been employed by the board for less than five years.

Four other Peel teachers were granted leaves of absence without pay last week, bringing the number of instructors granted leaves this year to 176.

Mary McWilliams of Harold F. Loughlin Public School, Barbara Davidson of Northwood Public School, Carole Ruff of Madoc Public School and Elaine Guard of Streetsville Secondary School are leaving because of health or family responsibilities.
