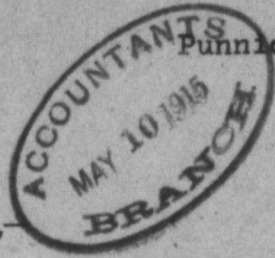

Sir,

Immediate action

I beg to ask the Department if the Annuity money for this Agency can be forwarded in time to permit me to commence the payments on June 1st.

My reason for wanting to commence the payments at an earlier date this year is that I am making every effort to have the summerfallowing plowed in June this year and the Indians will require their Annuity money to purchase food to enable them to do this work. I may say that there are very few sources of income available for them during the early summer months.

In order to reach here in time the money should be sent from Winnipeg on May, 31st.
