

Dear Sir,-

The Honourable the Superintendent General of Indian Affairs has transferred to me your letter to him of June 10, dealing with the proposed acquirement of a portion of the Osoyoos Indian Reserve No. 1, Okanagan agency, B.C.

In reply I have to inform you that Chief Inspector Ditchburn reported on this matter on the 27th of May, and on the 6th of June the papers were sent to Inspector Megraw at Vernon. He was asked to make an immediate report on the matter. It will be necessary to obtain a surrender from the Indians of the land required, and Inspector Megraw will be asked to report on that phase of the question.
