Referring to your letter of the 7th instant, I beg to say that you are hereby authorized to furnish relief supplies to the value of \$3.00 a week for three weeks to the family of Noel Barnaby, of the Burnt Church Reserve, consequent upon the fact that he sustained an injury which prevents him working for a time.

Assistance to the value of \$3.00 a week may also be furnished to the family of Pat Cloud, of the Eel Ground Reserve, who is ill with pneumonia. The assistance in this case may be afforded so long as is necessary. A further report in the matter should be submitted at a later date.
