re-Schkam Indian reserve No.2
Extra land for ballast pit

Your letter of the 18th instant and accompanying plan and description of the land patented in 1914 have been received.

The plan has been compared with our plan R.R.1126 and two slight differences are noted,- (1) The distance from the centre line to the South West corner of the parcel is given on your plan as 274.0, while our plan shows it as 274.3 and (2) The bearing easterly from the old I.P. is given as S.89°48'E on your plan and S.89°42'E on our plan. Neither of these are on the boundaries of the parcel patented but are intended as ties. Your plan is being held here for instructions as to how to make the plans agree.
