Reason: The applicant did not show acceptable grounds that the area could support or needed a local community station. The area receives service from Montreal stations.

Reason: Previous applications have been denied as it was the opinion of the Board that the area cannot support a station and it is the further opinion of the Board that the situation has not changed.

(c) Re Allan Rogerson, New Liskeard, Ont.

WHEREAS

At the 20th Meeting of the Board, May 1944, it was recommended that a licence for a 1000 watt station at New Liskeard be granted to Allan Rogerson provided that the applicant find a frequency:

AND WHEREAS

There has been no communication from Allan Rogerson regarding this matter since the 20th Meeting:

IT WAS RESOLVED

THAT the Minister of Reconstruction be advised that the Board of Governors of the Canadian Broadcasting Corporation recommends that the recommendation that Allan Rogerson be permitted to establish a 1000-watt station at New Liskeard, Ont. be withdrawn.

(d) Re Harvey Alsgard, Powell River, B.C.

WHEREAS

At the 42nd Meeting of the Board, June 5 and 6, 1945, it was recommended that a licence be granted to Harvey Alsgard to establish a 250-watt station at Powell River, B.C.;

AND WHEREAS

At the 44th Meeting of the Board, November 27, 28, and 29, 1945, the application was reconsidered and the previous decision confirmed;

AND WHEREAS

Harvey Alsgard has not proceeded to establish the station, contrary to Regulation 23 of The Radio Act, 1938;
