E. J. Campbell and J. Osborne of Arcela, Saskatchewan, and under the command of Pilot E. J. Campbell crashed approximately one-half mile west of Arcela, Saskatchewan. The pilot and passenger were killed and the aircraft was destroyed. 2. Indications are that the aircraft spun from the top of a loop as a result of the pilot attempting to fly the aircraft while under the influence of alcohol. 5.
