ed, deposited, thrown, or laid either from any vessel, boat, scow, or other such craft, or in any other manner, or by any person from any part of the beach or shore of the Harbor, into any part of the Harbor, or upon the beach or shore thereof, either below low-water mark, or between high and low water, under a penalty of forty dollars for each and every offence, to be paid by the owner or owners, master or person having charge of any vessel, boat or scow or other craft from which such matter as aforesaid shall have been discharged or by any person or persons violating this law.

BALLAST.

Rule 14.—No ballast, stone, gravel, earth or rubbish of any kind shall be unladen, cast, or emptied out of or thrown overboard from any sl.ip or vessel whatever in the Harbor, or at the entrance thereof, except in places which may be set apart for that purpose by the Harbor Master, under a penalty of eighty dollars for each and every offence, to be paid by the owner, master, or other person having charge of any such ship or vessel.

WHARVES.

Rule 15—In the construction, building or repairing of wharves within the limit of the Harbor, care must be taken that all the outside compartments of said wharves shall be filled with large stone ballast, and the inside compartments
