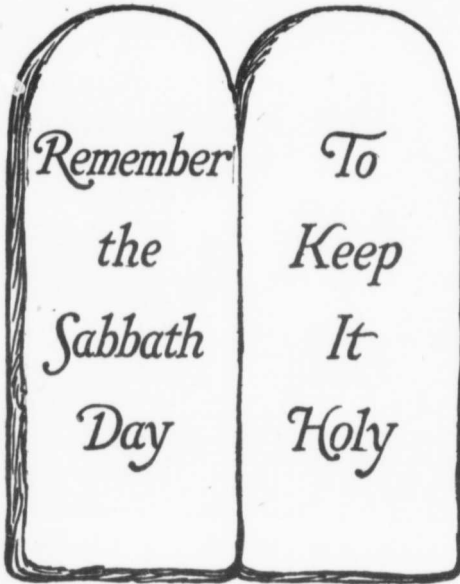


THE TEN COMMANDMENTS
