the Diffrict where fuch Wines, &c. are confumed that amount thereof may be received.

fuch Wines, Beer, Rum, and other diffilled Spirituous Liquors as are confumed, that he may receive the Amount thereof according to Law.

And to prevent Frauds, and for the Better fecuring the Payment of the faid Duties.

When Wines &c, are removed from one place to another, the Collector to transmit to the Collector of the District to which the same is removed a List of Permiss granted and Quantity of Liquors therein mentioned.

II. Be it Enacted, That when and so often as any Wines, Rum, and other distilled Spirituous Liquors shall be removed or transported by Permit from Halifax, or any other District to some other Place or District in the Province, the Collector or Receiver of the Place or District from whence such Wines, Rum and other distilled Spirituous Liquors shall be removed, shall transmit to the Collector or Receiver of the Flace or District to which the same shall be transported a list of all such Permits granted by him with the Names of the Persons to whom the same are granted, and the Quantity of Liquors therein mentioned.

Acts relating to Duties of Import and Excise III. And be it also Enacted, That an Act made in the fifteenth Year of his present Majesty's Reign, entitled, 'An Act in further addition to, and Amendment of, and for continuing the several Acts of the General Assembly of this Province therein mentioned,

relating to the Duties of Impost and Excise on Wines, Beer, bum and other distilled Spirituous Liquors," together with the

feveral Acts, recited and mentioned in the faid Act and the additions thereto made by this Act shall be and continue and the same are hereby continued in Force from the Expiration thereof until the Thirty First Day of December, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Seventy Eight.
