Mcntreal, June 14 .- Charged with the murder of Henry Bowman, a returned soldier, of Kingston, on January 16, Alexander Chaput was arrested here last night. According to the police reports, the body of the soldier was found lying in the street, dressed only in underwear and the rest of his clothes in a bundle by its side. The body was frozen stiff.
An autopsy showed that the man died of wounds on the head and at the inquest the jury returned a ver-dict of murder by unknown persons. Bowman at the time of his death was passing through Montreal from Halifax, having been engaged in relief work there.




