MANUFACTURE OF BEER BANNED AFTER DECEMBER

Washington, Sept. 6.—The manufacture of beer in the United States will be prohibited after December next, as a war measure. This announcement was made tonight by the Food Administration which said the decision had been reached at conferences between President Wilson and representatives of the Fuel and Railroad administrations and War Industries Board.
