




Assembly Dissolved. Fishery and


Yesterday the Governor dissolved the Assembly which was called together for the first time on May 31st, 1909. The men who took their seats four years ago are no longer mem-bers, and the Assembly itself has gone out of existence by the exercise of the Governor's prerogative by the advice of his Ministers. Had une this prerogative been delayed until the end of this week, the Assembly would have expired by force of the law provided for such a contingency, which muss as follows:

Bay de Verde—Little sign codfish; few salmon and lobster.

Trinity—Codfish scarce; few salmon caught.

"The House of Assembly shall continue..... for four years from the day on which they shall by proclamation be appointed to meet, unless sooner dissolved, and no longer.'

No House of Assembly can be called together, for there is no Assembly to call together, nor can there be until after the General Election, which will take place in November. For at least six months, no matter what emergency may arise this state of jeopardy must exist. The Government has run into this perilous state with its eyes op for warning after warning was given of the risk the course would entail. Indeed, during the Session of 1912 a
