BRANTFORD AGAIN LOST
TO SLUGGING LONDON TEAM

Deneau Tribe Batted Three Red Sox Pitchers Off the Rubber. —Steiger Started for Locals, But Had to Retire Later in Favor of Boldt, London's New Pitcher.

Maybe it isn't just the right thing picking on this Brantford bunch just because they are away down there in the coal bin of the Canadian League, but Rubie Deneau's club needs a lot of games on the winning side of the sheet in order to keep this Ottawa bunch within a respectable reaching distance, so J. Methuselah Keenan, Red Rowe and company have to take their turn being victims. They were victimized yesterday to the extent of 8 to 6 before a large and fashionable gathering, as the society reporter might put it, it being ladies' day over in the West London pasture. The ladies were present in full force.

LONDON HIT HARD AND OFTEN.

The only excuse the Tecumseh Parkers can give for winning the conflict is that they hit the ball when hits were needed and they hit the old pill hard. A total of 14 bingles was collected from the varied assortment of three Brantford slant artists, while the visiting relicts were only able to accumulate a total of nine from the joint offerings of Heine Steiger and Pitcher Boldt.

The locals tried to make it a walk away in the first few spasms, but the Red Sox smelled a plot and crabbed the little doings in the sixth and seventh, scoring a total of five runs in those two sessions. The fact that London had copped a total of six runs previous to this kept the locals in the lead, and they were never once threatened.

Steiger Started Well. Heine Steiger, London's second southpaw, was called upon by Manager Deneau to "shoot the pill," and Heine got away to a flying start. The Red Sox pitching problem fell to the lot of a husky gent named Malloy, who was once with the Detroit Tigers and various other ball clubs before finally locating himself in the Canadian League. Malloy has a funny, jerky way of delivering the ball, making his arm look like a corkscrew. He lasted just two innings. In that time London combed him for six hits and four runs. Then Clermont succeeded him.

Brantford's First Run. Steiger retired the Kaneless ones in order in the first three innings, but in the fourth Wagner led off with a single to left and scored a little later when Coose drove a safe one in the same direction. Steiger got through all right in the fifth, although he handed out a couple of passes, but he was able to stop the scoring, only one visitor got to him for four singles and three runs and followed this up with two hits and two more runs in the seventh. Rubie sent Boldt in after that, and he stopped the scoring, only one hit being piled on his assortment during the two innings he pitched.

Hit in the Pinches. Timely hitting scored most of London's runs. In the first inning, Linneborn singled and scored with a single to second. He stole third, and came in on Stewart's single to right. In the second inning, a real old-time hitting rally occurred. Neale was safe on Iver's miff, and after Deneau died on Smith got a Cincinnati hit. Steiger got an infield hit, and Linneborn singled to left, scoring Neale and Smith. Reidy's infield hit scored Steiger, and Linneborn was out at the plate trying to

score, the decision being a most questionable one.

In the third, another run was added, when Stewart walked, and was brought in by Dunlop's sacrifice and infield hits by Neale and Deneau.

Stewart scored a run in the third, when he singled, was sacrificed to second, went to third on Reidy's out, and scored on Bierbauer's single.

In the fifth Dunlop registered, after singling and going to second on a balk. Smith's single to centre scored him. The last run London scored was in the eighth. Clermont had been taken out in the seventh with the bases full, and Gero, who pitched Thursday's game, was sent in. Gero made Linneborn fly to Rowe for the final out. But in the eighth, Reidy was passed and sacrificed to second, and after Stewart fled out to Coose, Dunlop singled to centre, and Reidy came in.

Sox Score Three in Sixth. The Red Sox were not causing any anxiety by their earlier efforts, but in the sixth they started out in real earnest to overcome London's lead. Keenan led off, but grounded out. Coose got a life on Dunlop's bad throw, the London shortstop making a sensational stop of what looked like a hit, but throwing low to first. Ivers singled, but Slimeborn popped to Linneborn. Reidy came through with a triple to right at this stage, and the first two runners crossed the plate. Nelson singled to left and Rowe scored. Linneborn got the fourth clean hit of the inning, but Clermont was an easy strike-out.

In the seventh, singles by Keenan, a three-bagger by Coose, and a bad throw by Dunlop resulted in two more runs, the last runs that the Red Sox scored.

FAMOUS FIGHT BACKER
DIES AT NEW ORLEANS

"Bul" Renaud, Who Backed Sullivan-Kilrain Bout, Passes Away.

New Orleans, La., Aug. 16.—P. A. ("Bud") Renaud, aged 60, well known in sporting circles for many years, died here last night of cirrhosis of the liver. Renaud was one of the backers of the Sullivan-Kilrain bare-knuckle fight in Mississippi in 1889. He also backed James J. Corbett in a fight with Kilrain here in 1891, and is credited with having much to do with bringing out Corbett.
