Present Tense.

<i>Sing.</i>	Kespin zhahwanegayaun,	If I love.	<i>Sing</i>
	Kespin zhahwanegayun,	If thou lovest.	
	Kespin zhahwahnegaid,	If he loves.	
<i>Plur.</i>	Kespin zhahwanegayong,	If we love.	<i>Plur</i>
	Kespin zhahwanegayaig,	If you love.	
	Kespin zhahwanegawod,	If they love.	

INFINITIVE MOOD.

<i>Pres.</i>	Chezahwanegang,	To love.	<i>Sing</i>
<i>Perf.</i>	Chegezahwanegang,	To have loved.	
<i>Fut.</i>	Ahyegwahwezhahwanegang,	To be about to love.	<i>Plur</i>

PARTICIPLES.

Present, Zhahwaneding, Loving.
Perfect, Zhahwanemind, Loved.

CONJUGATION OF THE VERB TO BE.

INDICATIVE MOOD.

Present Tense.

<i>Sing.</i>	Nedahyah,	I am.	<i>Plur</i>
	Kedahyah,	Thou art.	
	Ahyah,	He is,	
<i>Plur.</i>	Nedahyahmin,	We are.	<i>Sing</i>
	Kedahyaum,	Ye or you are.	
	Ahyahwug,	They are.	

Imperfect Tense.

<i>Sing.</i>	Nedahyahnahbun,	I was.	<i>Plur</i>
	Kedahyahnahbun,	Thou wast.	
	Ahyahbun,	He was.	
<i>Plur.</i>	Nedahyahmenahbun,	We were.	
	Kedahyahmwahbun,	You were.	
	Ahyahbahneeg,	They were.	

Perfect Tense.

<i>Sing.</i>	Negeahyahnahbun,	I have been.	<i>Koor</i>
	Kegeahyahnahbun,	Thou hast been.	<i>Koor.</i>
	Keahyahbun,	He has been.	<i>Koor.</i>
<i>Plur.</i>	Negeahyahmin,	We have been.	<i>Koor</i>
