ANNEX A to Schedule of Terms and Conditions dated 26 November 1979

TRAINING AT CANADIAN FORCES BASE SUFFIELD

- 1. Canada undertakes to provide, assist, or act on behalf of the United Kingdom in obtaining the materiel, equipment, supplies, services and facilities listed in the paragraphs hereunder.
 - 2. Canada (National Defence Headquarters) shall provide:
 - (a) the use of Camp Crowfoot, (Note: This camp referred to as Camp Vacuum in the original agreement);
 - (b) maintenance to Canadian standards of the buildings used by the British Forces and works services as may be agreed;
 - (c) married quarters, as for Canadian Forces personnel of equivalent rank; and
 - (d) the use of buildings as listed in the Building Register attached as Appendix 1 subject to such additions and subtractions as may be made by way of administrative arrangements accepted by both the Canadian Base Commander and the British military authorities.
 - 3. Canada shall assist the United Kingdom in obtaining:
 - (a) facilities at Calgary Airport for use as an airhead for service and civilian charter aircraft employed on the movement of personnel and freight between Europe and Suffield;
 - (b) facilities at the port of entry and exit for tanks, vehicles, equipment and stores, including ammunition;
 - (c) use of railways to move vehicles, stores and equipment including Chieftain tanks and ammunition between agreed exit and entry points;
 - (d) use of commercial buses under contract for movement of personnel between Calgary and Suffield; and
 - (e) medical, educational and dental facilities.
 - 4. The United Kingdom may use the following Canadian defence establishment facilities and services to such an extent as they may find necessary subject to agreement by the Base Commander of Canadian Forces Base Suffield:
 - (a) the Carpenter's Shop;
 - (b) the Machine Shop for specialist work;
