Employment opportunities for spouses are limited as the Cameroonian government encourages the hiring of Cameroonians where possible in all sectors of the economy. In spite of this, most spouses who wish to work outside the home will not have great difficulty in finding a job.

Embassies, international organizations, hospitals, some foreign companies, and schools are generally exempt from these regulations and thus there are some opportunities for office employment in secretarial, administrative and accounting capacities. Jobs are usually available in areas where local skills are lacking such as professors, engineers, scientists, nurses, doctors, etc.
