TO THE PARTIES TO THE AGREEMENT ON ENDING THE WAR AND
RESTORING PEACE IN VIETNAM

The secretary of State for External Affairs of Canada presents his compliments to the Parties to the Agreement on Ending the War and Restoring Peace in Viet-Nam, signed at Paris, January 27, 1973 by the Parties and has the honour to refer to his Note of May 31, 1973.

The Secretary of State for External Affairs has the honour to inform the Parties that when, in accordance with the provisions of his Note of May 31 referred to above, Canada terminates its participation in the International Commission of Control and Supervision on July 31, 1973, then the Government of Canada, in accordance with the statement made on March 1, 1973 by the Secretary of State for External Affairs, on the occasion of his signing the Act of the International Conference on Viet-Nam, will no longer regard itself as bound by the arrangements provided for in that Act especially the provisions of Articles 6 and 7 as they relate to Canada as a participant in the International Commission of Control and Supervision.
