BARTON, W. H.

Mr. W. H. Barton joined the Department of External Affairs in 1954 after having worked in the Defence Research Board from 1946. He was Counsellor in the Canadian Embassy in Vienna and was the Alternate Governor for Canada to the International Atomic Energy Agency. From 1961 to 1964 he served as Counsellor and then Minister at the Canadian Permanent Mission to the United Nations in New York. In May 1970 he was appointed Assistant Under-Secretary of State for External Affairs. In June 1972, Mr. Barton was named Ambassador and Permanent Representative of Canada to the Office of the United Nations and to other International Organizations at Geneva.
