Ms. Judith Padua was born in 1941 and has a B.A. in Sociology from the University of Alberta and an M.A. in the Sociology of Development and Research Methods, Facultad Latino Americana de Ciencias Sociales, in Santiago, Chile. Since 1984, she has been Executive Director of the Clifford E. Lee Foundation, a private, Edmonton-based foundation with an annual grants program in the areas of social and international development and culture. Since 1985, she has been a member of the Board of Directors (and since 1987, Vice President) of World University Service of Canada (WUSC), a non-profit, non-governmental organization involving the Canadian academic community in social and economic development at home and in developing countries.

Ms. Padua is also a member of the Board of Directors of the Canadian Centre for Philanthropy, a Toronto-based organization, and a former Vice President of the Edmonton Social Planning Council. She has lived in Chile, Argentina and Mexico.
