Question No. 1,063, by Mr. Laprise,—Order of the House for a Return showing: 1. How much has been expended by the federal government on the Indian reservation at Weymontachie (near Sanmaur) each year since 1955?

2. What is the name of the firm or firms which supply this Indian reservation?

Question No. 1,072, by Mr. Laing,—Order of the House for a Return showing: What is (a) man hours of work (b) value of labour content, in each \$10,000 of production of the following items in Canada: (i) automobiles (ii) wheat (iii) milk (iv) canned fruits and vegetables (v) house-building (vi) oil at well-head (vii) farm implements (viii) average lead-zinc production (ix) newsprint (x) plywood (xi) herring for reduction (xii) canned sockeye salmon?

Question No. 1,073, by Mr. Matheson,—Order of the House for a Return showing: Following the successful launching of the Canadian satellite "Alouette" from the Pacific Missile Range on September 29, 1962:

(1) To what extent have the measurement and telemetry systems in the satellite operated successfully since launching?

(2) What new scientific information has so far been obtained from an analysis of the data received from the satellite?

(3) How many Canadian scientists and engineers were employed on the design, development, and testing of this satellite, and for what period of time?

(4) What steps have been taken by the government through its Trade Commissions and other avenues to publicize this achievement outside Canada?

(5) Are additional satellite experiments planned by the Defence Research Board or the National Research Council and, if so, at what time may the next launching be expected, and what functions will these future satellites be designed to perform?

*Question No. 1,087, by Mr. Batten,—Order of the House for a Return showing: 1. Is there a special living allowance paid to members of the Canadian Armed Forces stationed in certain areas in Newfoundland and, if so, what are the names of these areas?

2. What was the amount of this allowance on January 1, 1962?

3. Has there been any reduction in this allowance since January 1, 1962 and, if so (a) how much was the reduction (b) at what date was the reduction effective?

4. Are any further reductions in this allowance contemplated?
