

THE HOUSE OF COMMONS OF CANADA

BILL 20.

An Act respecting the Baptist Convention of Ontario and Quebec.

1889, c. 105;
1911, c. 38.

WHEREAS the Baptist Convention of Ontario and Quebec has by its petition prayed that it may be enacted as hereinafter set forth, and it is expedient to grant the prayer of the said petition: Therefore His Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows:— 5

1. Paragraph (*g*) of section five of chapter one hundred and five of the statutes of 1889, as enacted by section two of chapter thirty-eight of the statutes of 1911, is repealed and the following is substituted therefor:— 10

“(*g*) A Board for promoting religious education through the study of the Bible and other agencies, and for the extension of Sunday School and Young People’s work to be called “The Board of Religious Education of the Baptist Convention.” 15
