AFTER the conquest of the province of Canada, by the arms of Great Britain, your petitioners, in compliance with his Majesty's gracious and royal proclamation bearing date the 7th day of October 1763, settled and became established in the new acquired colony of Quebec, in the sull reliance on the saith of the Crown of Great Britain, as expressed in that proclamation, for the enjoyment of those laws, that freedom and security in Canada, which the principles
