Varsity Field To Be Formally Opened Sept. 30

It is expected that by Sept. 30 the new Varsity Athletic Field will be formally opened by a Rugby game between the coming year's senior Varsity team and a team composed of ex-Varsity players. No better opening could possibly be made for the new stadium, particularly when so many of the players who comprised Varsity's championship teams of 1916 and 1917 are still in or near the city.

Billie Poulis, quarter-back for Varsity last year, may play on one of the city teams this year.

On present indications, Argonauts are going to have the best Varsity team that has represented the city in years.

The interprovincial Rugby Union will meet this afternoon at the King Edward Hotel for the purpose of drawing up the senior schedule and another business. President Joseph Wright will call the meeting to order at 2 o'clock in Room B.

The Canadian Rugby Union have sent to the different Rugby unions in the following classes for consideration during the coming year, so that when the meeting is held for consideration of the annual meeting all the unions will be in a position to thoroughly discuss the matter.

(1) It is recommended by the executive of the C.R.U. that the Varsity teams belonging to the C.R.U. affiliate themselves with the Amateur Athletic Union of Canada.

(2) It has been suggested that the kick-off after a drop goal be the same as a regular kick, with the substitution of the 40-yard line for the 35-yard line.

(3) When the ball is kicked without touching an opponent on the opponent's dead-line or into touch, he shall not count any score, but he shall be allowed to kick the ball back into play from the 35-yard line.

(4) That the different unions must be notified that their championship must be decided not later than the second Saturday in November.

W. M. Gladish has been appointed eastern junior representative of the C.R.U. to succeed James Brydon, who is now in Winnipeg.

The semi-annual meeting of the O.R.U. will be held at the King Edward Hotel at 2 o'clock. An executive meeting will be held at 2:30.

The O.R.U. F.U. expect to have a three-day junior union in Toronto. Toronto will be represented by T. A. Alperman, J. M. C. A. Don Rowing Club, Toronto Canoe Club and some four or five other clubs. Hamilton will have the Rowing Club and the Alerts, and the University of Toronto.

With the appointment of Fred Chittick as the Ottawa representative for today's big meeting of the interprovincial Rugby Football Union last night's meeting of the Ottawa club executive dwindled down to a discussion of the available players for this year's team. The arrival of Jack Williams in Ottawa assures the return of the star to the red, white and black, while there are a few of the interprovincial Rugbyists who will figure in the Ottawa line-up this fall. The Ottawa will get out this afternoon on their square for a little limbering up, but the first real practice is called for next Tuesday afternoon on the Rideau ball grounds. The team will transfer to Lansdowne Park just as soon as the big show is thru.

The Quebec Rugby Football Union will hold its annual meeting Sept. 9, applications for membership will be considered from Westmount A. A. (intermediate) and Bishop's College School, Lennoxville (junior).
