WITH THE HARNESS HORSES

Dan Patch Holds Three Records to His Credit.

Dan Patch, 1.5, has three world's records to his credit, all made over the Allentown, Pa., half-mile track, viz.—Half mile in 59 1-4, one mile in 1:01, one mile to wagon, 2:05. Millard Sanders was recently shown out of a cart and quite seriously hurt while showing a horse at Indianapolis. G. A. Brown, Lexington, Ont., has bought the young jockey King Arthur by Monbars, 2:11 3-4, out of the dam of La Pointe, 2:09 1-4, and Cap Miller, by Christmas Chimes, out of the dam of Hal Patron, 2:13 1-4. Ardelia, 2:04 3-4, also slightly lame, managed to keep on winning. But for hitting one of his sulky wheels rounding the last turn of the Allentown, Pa., half-mile track, Dan Patch would doubtless have lowered the record for a two-lap ring to two minutes or better week ago Wednesday, when he started to beat his own mark. The first quarter was 29.3, the first half 59.1, and he was coming on strong and true when he hit the wheel, which caused him to break. The fractional time of his mile there last season was 1:00 1-2, 1:00 1-2, 1:00 1-2, and 2:01. "Kentucky's great trot" began next Tuesday, Oct. 2, and there promises to be such a gathering of the clans at Lexington as has never been seen there on all its history.

To Fight on Sunday.

Leavenworth, Kan., Sept. 27.—Joe Walcott and Billy Hines, who were prevented from fighting on Sunday by the authorities, have signed new articles for a 20-round battle next Sunday for the welterweight championship of the world and a purse of \$2000. The fight Sunday will be under the auspices of the Leavenworth Athletic and Promoters, who guarantee that they will pull it off without interference. The exact location of the battleground will not be made public before Sunday morning, but it is stated that it will be in close proximity to Leavenworth. Sheriff Meyers and County Attorney Bond say they will not permit the fight to take place in Leavenworth County, and the promoters say they have no intention of pulling it off in this county. Walcott and Rhodes have resumed training.
