Practical demonstrations of the method of performing surgical operations without employing ligatures were given by Dr. Downes at clinics in several cities in Europe.

In all surgical operations, as usually performed, hemorrhage is controlled by the use of ligatures, and it seems almost inconceivable that anything more practical could be evolved.

The new method consists of the use of various sized pressure forceps, of special design, in the biades of which is heated by the passage of a suitable electrical current thru it. It cooks the tissue under pressure, oblinite earling its blood vessels. The process is an absolutely asseptic one.
