

6. The following declaration shall be made before the Metropolitan, or some person duly appointed by him, by the Bishop elect, before his consecration, or, if already consecrated, before exercising any episcopal functions in this diocese: "I, N., chosen bishop of the See of Fredericton, do promise that I will teach and maintain the doctrine and discipline of the Church of England, and I also do declare that I consent to be bound by all the Rules and Regulations which have heretofore been made, and which may from time to time be made by the Synod of the Diocese of Fredericton; and in consideration of being appointed bishop of the said See of Fredericton, I hereby undertake immediately to resign the said appointment, together with all the rights and emoluments appertaining thereto, if sentence requiring such resignation should at any time be passed upon me, after due examination had, by the tribunal acknowledged or appointed by the Synod of the said Diocese for the trial of a bishop; saving the rights of appeal allowed by the said Synod."

7. The above declaration in writing, signed by the Bishop elect, or a certified copy thereof, shall be filed with the Secretary of the Synod.
