We, the undersigned Chief and Councillors of the Band of Indians owning the Reserve situated in Treaty No. Three and known as "Coucheching Reserve," do, by these presents, certify that the said Band has by vote of the majority of its voting members present at a meeting summoned for the purpose, according to the rules of the Band, and held in the presence of the Indian Agent for the locality on the 22nd day of February 1914 granted leave to Frank Breyere to join our said Band, and as a member thereof to share in all land and other privileges of the Band, to which admission we, the undersigned, also give full consent.
