Seed-vessels of a palm, <i>Acrocomia sclerocarpa</i>, Mast., from the West Indies.</p> <p>Seeds of <i>Eleocarpus oblongus</i>, Gaertner; from the Nilgherries.</p> <p>Seeds of the Great Elephant Creeper, <i>Entada pusætha</i>, Decandolle. From the Sikkim Terai, Eastern Himalayas.</p> <p>Fossil wood, from the petrified forest near Cairo, Egypt, and several other miscellaneous objects.</p> <p>Egg of the Red-Shouldered Hawk, <i>Buteo lineatus</i>, from Sorel.</p> <p>Specimen of the Glass Rope Sponge, <i>Hyalonema Sieboldii</i>, from Japan, and 12 species of Wenlock limestone fossils.</p> <p>An exchequer tally.</p> <p>Pair of Pine Grosbeaks.</p> <p>1 Downy Woodpecker.</p> <p>Cast of an Indian pipe, the original of which was found at Port Hope, Ont.</p> <p>Pair of Canvas-backed Ducks.</p> <p>A Pigeon hawk, <i>Hypotriorchis columbarius</i>.</p> <p>Common Grey Parrot.</p>
