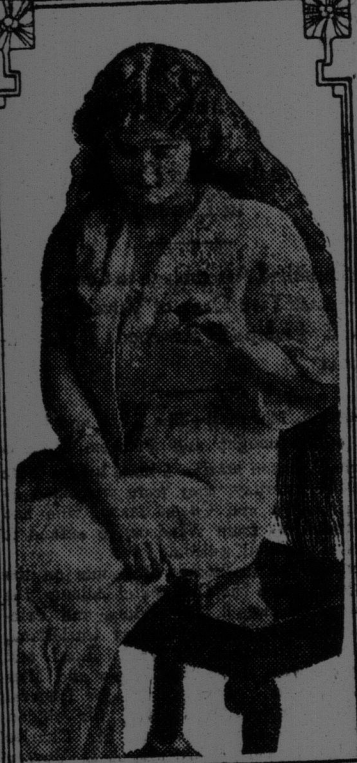

AT SAND POINT

The Royal Mail steamer Empress of Ireland, from Liverpool, docked at No. 3 berth on Saturday afternoon at 4.30 with 1413 passengers, and the Allan liner Corinthian from London and Havre docked at No. 6, fifteen minutes later with 867 passengers.

Several concerts were held on the Ireland and the proceeds will be divided between Canadian and Liverpool institutions for seamen. Among the passengers was a party of 40 Englishmen who are on their way to Toronto to be married to young Englishwomen yesterday at 3 o'clock with 428 passengers and those will land this morning.

The Manchester Inventor, which arrived yesterday at noon, went to No. 5 berth at 4.30 to discharge freight. The inventor encountered furious gales and high seas and the ship battled for five days with winds of hurricane force and was continually swept by heavy seas.

On Wednesday last a wireless was received by Captain Bannister of the Corinthian, warning him of an iceberg in latitude 42.47 north and longitude 49.19 west and the Allan liner went further south and did not sight the berg.
