OVERTURE ANENT HONORARY DEGREES.

The Overture from the Presbytery of Glengary anent Honorary Degrees, laid over from the last meeting of Synod, was next taken up and considered. It was moved by Mr. James Gordon and seconded by Mr. Wilkins, That the Overture be referred to a Committee, with instructions to report at a future Diet. To this it was moved in amendment by Mr. Joshua Fraser and seconded by Mr. Mann, That the Overture be dismissed. A vote having been taken, the Amendment was carried over the Motion by a majority of 41 to 2 and the Moderator declared accordingly.
