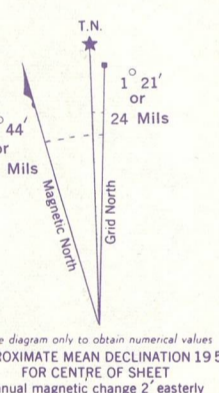

REFERENCE

- Roads:
  - hard surface, all weather... more than 2 lanes
  - hard surface, all weather... 2 lanes
  - loose surface, all weather... 2 lanes wide or more
  - loose surface, less than 2 lanes... all weather
  - Private Road
  - Trail
  - Railway: double track, single track, abandoned, narrow gauge or electric
  - Bridge, underpass or overpass
  - Boundaries: International, Provincial, County, Township, Reservation Indian, Military Hill or Post Parks, etc.
  - Electric Power Line
  - Telephone trunk route
  - Tranquilization Station
  - Boundary of Survey Monument
  - Bench Mark
  - Spot Elevation, (in feet)
  - House, Barn

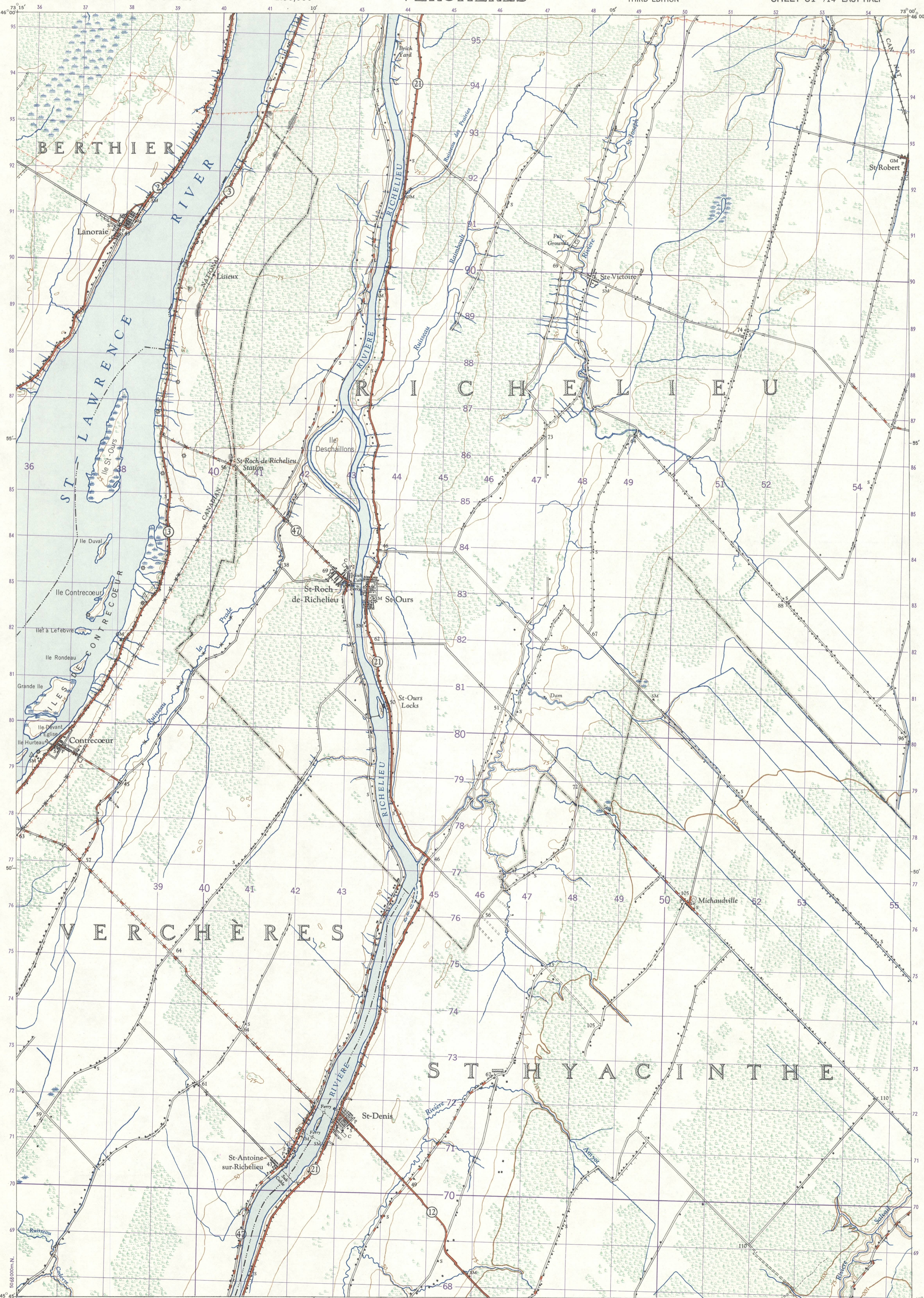
ONE THOUSAND METRE UNIVERSAL TRANSVERSE MERCATOR GRID ZONE 18

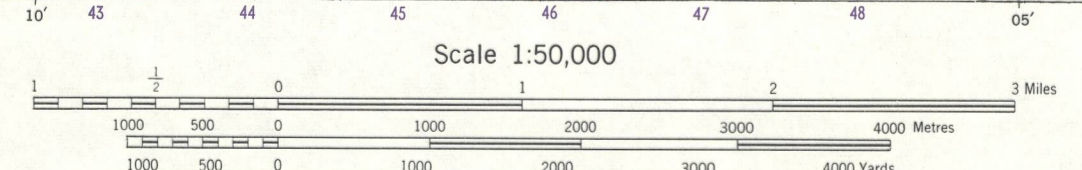

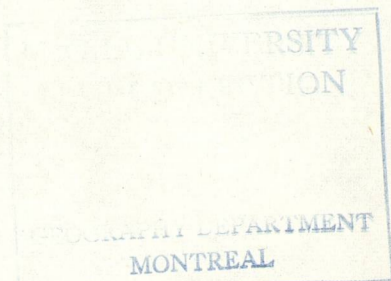
