NOTICE TO HOLDERS OF TIMBER LICENSES. The attention of all holders of Timber Licenses is called to Section 19 of the Timber Regulations, which reads as follows: "No Spruce or Fir tree shall be cut by any Licensee under any License, not even for piling, which will not make a log at least 18 feet in length and ten inches at the small end, and any such shall be cut, the License shall be liable to forfeiture."
