Refined Table Manners. Refined table manners mark not only good breeding, but good feeling, and whatever else in the dinner table, the dinner is not. It takes time to enjoy delicate flavors, and to appreciate those dishes which ought to be real works of art, not only in order that the gastric juice may have time to thoroughly mingle with the food, but that we may rise from the level of the animal to that of a higher order of being.

I have formed a settled conviction that the world is fed too much. Pastries, cakes, hot-breads, rich gravies, pickles, cream soups, and all the rest of it, are discarded from my 'bill of fare' and I firmly believe that they will be from the recipes of the twentieth century.

Bear in mind that lemons are the most useful fruit in economy. The juice of half a lemon in a teaspoon of strong black coffee, without sugar, will often cure a sick headache. Lemon juice and salt will remove the ordinary rust. If the hands are stained there is nothing that will remove the stains so well as lemon. Cut a lemon in half and apply the cut surface as if it were soap. Lemon juice is also a remedy for rheumatism and for the so-called biliousness of spring.

The changeable weather gives many persons cold in the head. Colds of this kind may often be relieved, at least in the incipient stage, by sniffing camphor. A lump of camphor gum, or a little val of spirits of camphor, will serve the purpose. A small lump of the gum is easily carried about, and it should be sniffed with a long inhalation, as often as possible, for a day or two. The relief is often speedy.

sugar, brush the edges with egg and fold the other half over the fruit; press the edges together, ornament them, and brush the turnover with white egg. Lift over them powdered sugar and bake on tin dusted with flour for 20 minutes.

Tomato Sauce. Take 2 nice tomatoes, cut them into round slices, place on a plate, sprinkle some sugar, a little pepper, a spoonful of olive oil and a tablespoon of best vinegar over the tomatoes, and serve them up.

THE FARM. The Ploughing of Orchards. Whether orchards should or should not be ploughed must largely depend on previous management. Ploughing should be the rule while the trees are young, and growth rather than fruit is desired.

One of the reasons why clover is injurious to orchards is that it is not in condition for ploughing under until the trees are in full leaf. It is a great pity, for clover is so good a renovator of the soil that we naturally want to make it help to maintain the fertility of the orchard.

I have a young apple orchard which for the most of the time since planting has been kept under cultivation. Crops of corn, potatoes, and beans have within a year or two been raised on the soil of the orchard with but few weeds.

It is remarkable how quickly a tree will respond to intelligent treatment for the production of fruit. Accident excepted, vigorous trees in the orchard will bear fruit in the first year after they are planted.

The chief objection to causing apple roots to grow near the surface is their liability to injury when the soil freezes very deeply. But in very cold winters, no matter how orchard roots have been grown, they will need some protection by mulching the surface.

It is supposed by some that when any invigorator is to be applied to trees or vines, it cannot be used too freely, and they accordingly mix it with water to the damage of whatever is planted out, and wonder that it does not grow more vigorously.

Now, any one who knows that roots or seeds placed in a dung hill will not thrive, and

this should teach all that manure only furnishes a portion of the elements required for the support of vegetation, and that a bed of manure or horse manure, a tree or vine is only an impediment to its growth. A pint of bone dust will work a greater benefit to a tree or vine, when worked into the surface soil, than a bushel of whole bones under the roots, and so will a few shovelfuls of decomposed guano increase the growth of any plant more than a cart load of manure put in beneath the roots.
