By the Honorable Mr. McDonald,— of Henry Ecynolds and others, of the Counties of Wellington and Huron; of James Perkins, and others, of the County of Huron all of the Province of Ontario.

By the Honorable Mr. Alexander,—of L. B. Brown and others, of the County of Oxford, in the Province of Ontario.

By the Honorable Mr. McClelan,—of William Sutton and others, of Sarawak, in the County of Grey, in the Province of Ontario.

Pursuant to the Order of the Day, the following Petitions were severally read:-

Of the Board of Trade of the City of London, in the Province of Ontarie; praying for the removal of the Tax and Excise upon Petroleum.

Of the said Board of Trade; praying for the removal of Stamp duty on Notes and Bills of Exchange for sums under one hundred dollars.

Of the Great Western Ruilway Company; praying for the passing of an Act authorizing the construction of a Branch Railway from some point on the line of the said Railway at or near the Town of Clifton to a point at or near the Village of Allanburgh, in the County of Welland, and the extension thereof to some point on the Canada Air Line Branch of the said Great Western Railway, and for other purposes.

Of W. H. Storey & Co., and others, of Acton, in the Province of Ontario; praying for the amendment of the Tariff so as to provide for the protection of manufacturing interests.

Of the Honorable Charles Wilson and others, of the City of Montreal; praying for an Act of incorporation as "Le Uredit Foncier Royal."

Of the Royal Canadian Insurance Company; praying that their Act of incorporation may be amended by extending their power to do business in Fire and Marine Insurance risks outside of the Dominion, and by increasing the Capital Stock of the Company.

Of Theodore Hart and others, of the City of Montreal; praying for an Act of incorporation as "The Maritime Insurance Company."

Of the Reverend P. C. Moore and others, of Samuel Burdick and others, of East Nissouri, in the County of Oxford,—and of the Municipal Councils of the Townships of Blandford and Lobo, all in the Province of Ontario; severally praying for the passing of an Act prohibiting the sale of intoxicating liquors as beverages in the Dominion of Canada.
