

An Act to amend chapter thirty-two of the Consolidated Statutes of Canada, intituled "An Act respecting the Bureau of Agriculture and Agricultural Societies.

WHEREAS it is expedient to make more stringent enactments to de- Preamble.
termine and fix the purposes to which Agricultural Societies in
Lower Canada may devote the moneys placed in their possession from
time to time for the encouragement of agriculture: and whereas it is
5 important that the said Act should be amended in other respects:

Therefore, Her Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Council and Assembly of Canada, enacts as follows:

1. From and after the passing of this Act it shall not be lawful for
any Director or officer of an Agricultural Society in Lower Canada to
10 obtain any money or article from the said Society out of the moneys
which shall have been thereto subscribed either by himself or by other
subscribers, or out of the moneys allowed by the Government to such
Society, so long as he shall continue to be a Director or officer thereof,
under any pretext or in any manner whatsoever, either directly or in-
15 directly, for his own advantage or the advantage of any member of his
family; provided always that any officer or Director of an agricultural
society may take prizes at the exhibitions of the County Agricultural
Societies, of which he is at the time an officer or director, by conform-
ing strictly to the same conditions as other competitors at such exhibi-
tion, and not otherwise: provided also that the Secretary-Treasurer
20 may receive his per centage of the amounts really subscribed and the
amount of the Government grant really received by him, and no more.

2. All By-laws, restrictions or other acts passed by the majority of
the officers and directors of such societies, in contravention of the pre-
ceding section, shall be null and void to all intents and purposes

3. Any officer or director of an Agricultural Society who shall here-
after on conviction before a court of competent jurisdiction, be found
guilty of the offence or offences above set forth, shall be liable to a fine
of not less than ten dollars nor more than twenty dollars, and shall
further be disqualified to act as President, Vice-President, Secretary-
30 Treasurer or Director of any Agricultural Society, or to be re-elected
to such offices for the future, and such fact shall render such election
null.
