## C A P. XXVII.

An Act for encouraging new Settlers in His Majesty's Colonies and Plantations in America.



HEREAS it is expedient that En= Preamble. couragement hould be given to Perfons that are disposed to come and settle in certain of Wis Waselly's Co= Ionies and Plantations in America and the West Indies; be it therefore enafted by the King's moft Ercel-

lent Majetty, by and with the Advice and Consent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the Authority of the same, That, from and after the First Day of From Aug. August One thousand seven hundzed and ninety, if any of the United Person or Persons, being a Subject or Subjects of the states of Ame-Territozies oz Countries belonging to the United States in the Babama Iflands, &c. of America, thall come from thence, together with his may import Negroes, &c. of their Family of Families, to any of the Bahama, of Duty-free, to the Bermuda of Somers Mands, of to any Part of the 1920. herein specified, &c. vince of Quebec, or of Nova Scotia, or any of the Cerritoxies belonging to Dis Waselly in North America, for the Purpose of restoing and settling there, it shall be lawful for any fuch Person or Persons, having first obtained a Licence for that Purpose from the Governor, or, ín
