 tion for which has been sent to the OMB.
 Spearheading the move for change are councillors Caye Killaby and Jack Kehoe.

A clearer indication of the proposal for change in the ward system can be gleaned from the accompanying maps.

Council will consider the suggestion at its next meeting in 2½ weeks.

Town staff last week projected population figures for each ward for 1975 as being: Ward 1, 28,328; Ward 2, 41,686; Ward 3, 39,460; Ward 4, 44,547; Ward 5, 22,025; Ward 6, 52,927; and Ward 7, 20,297.

Committee suggested last week that wards 4 and 6 would be subject to a lot of development, including Mississauga City Centre and the proposed Erin Mills new town and Markborough projects, and indicated that the wards may later have to be split into probably four.

If the proposed annexa-

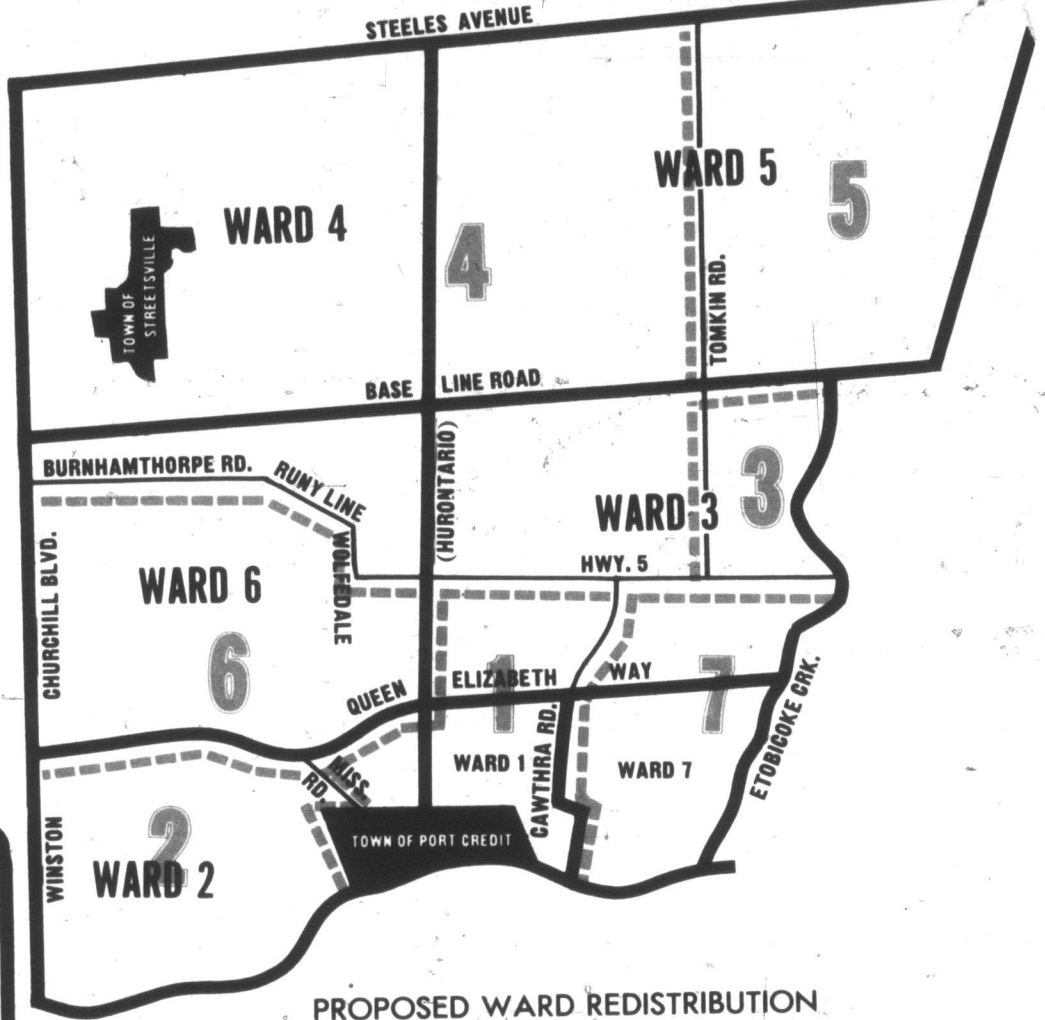
tion of Streetsville is approved by the OMB the town would most likely become a ward in Mississauga.

Though the tournaments will no longer be allowed as board-sponsored functions, church and other groups can get permission from the board to use school facilities as long as they accept all responsibility.

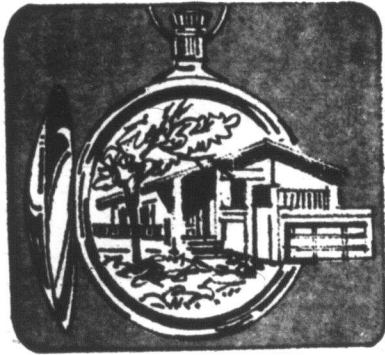
The Trustees were told by Academic Affairs Supervisor, Art Cummins, the administration could not be held responsible for all-night tournaments.

 guacious Deputy-Reeve Terry Miller, a scheme to bring the county health unit to provincial standards by adding 20 nurses in three years went out the window, despite comparative figures that pegged Peel's health expenditure among the

lowest in the province: \$2.10 per capita, against \$3.17 for Halton and \$6.77 for Toronto.

Next to get the axe was the road budget, dropped \$50,000 from \$2,387,830 to \$2,337,830 on a motion by Reeve Murray.

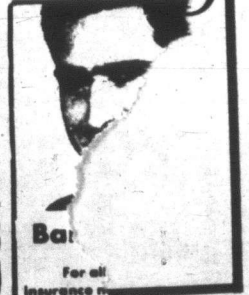
An amendment by Streetsville Mayor Hazel McCallion to cut \$100,000 from the road budget was defeated after Mayor Speck pointed out the province might reinstate the austerity measure in 1971.

A similar move by Albion Deputy-Reeve Edgar Wilson to reduce the health unit budget another five per cent was likewise defeated.
