

so granted shall be inalienable by the Indian
 Grantees or their heirs without the Consent
 of the Executive Government.

An Interpreter of the Indian
 Department, conversant with the Languages
 of these Tribes, may be directed to reside at
 the Settlement, as Assistant to the Superintending Officer.

The Name of any able-bodied
 Indian who may refuse to accept a
 location at the Settlement to be erased
 from the List of Indians entitled to
 Annual Presents.

Any Indian Settler who
 shall be reported absent without
 leave for the space of One Month
 between the first of April and
 first of December, of the first or
 second Year will be considered as
 having forfeited his location at the
 Settlement, and all further Claim
