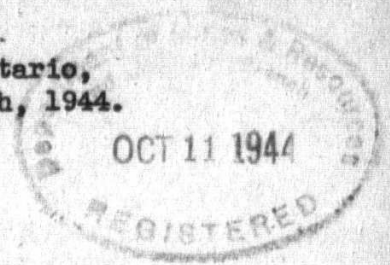

MEMORANDUM: THE DEPUTY MINISTER

The Pasqua Band of Indians in the Qu'Appelle Agency in the Province of Saskatchewan passed a resolution dated June 12, 1944, for the expenditure of \$1500.00 from their funds for the following purposes:

Roads - \$800.00 - This is the main road running east and west through the reserve. It is nine miles long and is used by all Indians journeying to the Post Office and to Fort Qu'Appelle.

Fencing - \$150.00 - This expenditure is in connection with rebuilding the pasture fence around the community pasture which is used for all stock of the reserve.

Dams - \$550.00 - There are four dams to be rebuilt and raised. These dams are for the purpose of conserving water for Indian stock. Mr. Christianson and Indian Agent Booth recommend the expenditure and I would be pleased to have the approval of the Minister. The balance in the Revenue Account of the Pasqua Band is \$12,538.85.
